

Peak Education has worked for more than 20 years to help youth from low-income backgrounds earn admission into college and reach for their educational potential. Peak Education's recent expansion efforts include a new partnership with Manitou schools. Our services include monthly meetings that explore goal setting, building a growth mindset and opportunities to connect with "keynote" guest speakers. In high school, students receive intensive college and scholarship counseling. Throughout the program students receive mentoring support with maintaining their grades and working toward their personal goals, involvement in community service and impact programming and opportunities for the entire family to connect around meaningful topics.
