Former MSSD14 Football Coach to be Celebrated, Inducted into CHSAA Hall of Fame

Manitou Springs, CO - Former Manitou Springs High School Football Coach George Rykovich will be celebrated at the October 21 football game for his recent Colorado High School Activities Association Hall of Fame election.

Coach Rykovich is the second Manitou Springs High School representative to be elected to the hall of fame with Justin Armour being the first.

Rykovich coached the team from 1971-2006. In that time, he led the Mustangs to 222 wins (17th all-time in state history) and two state championships (1987 and 1990).

Former players and alumni are invited to congratulate Coach Rykovich at halftime of the La Junta game on October 21. It is a home game and starts at 7 pm.

Rykovich will formally be inducted into the CHSAA Hall of Fame on January 23, 2023.
